Female Sexual Development

Changes in five lines of development.:

- 1) Change of object
- 2) Change from masculinity to feminity
- 3) Change from the active to the passive position
- 4) Changes in the erotogenic zones
- 5) Changes on the ego line

Female Sexual Development

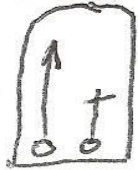
- The error and confusion created by calling the first phase (phallic-oedipal) pre-oedipal. A triangular relation.

- **The role of the parent's oedipal constellation on how the overtures of the oedipal child are received. The ego experiences, etc**

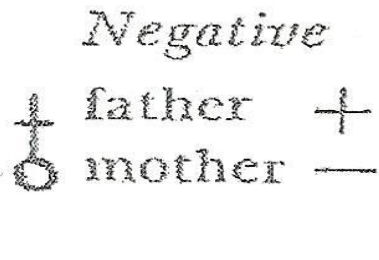
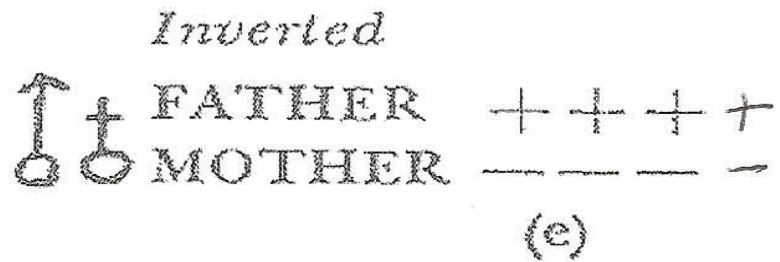
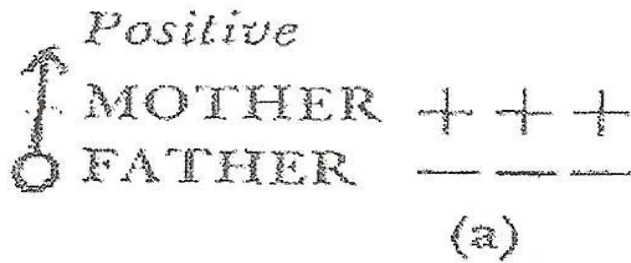
Female Sexual Development
